Training

- Two courses

 - Need film clips demonstrating good practice
 - Particularly with older people
- Looking at online learning / training resources

Developing ASCOT

- Further work around validity and reliability of ASCOT-INT4 and SCT4
- Further work around usability of CH3 & reliability
- New versions of ASCOT in development
 - Carer version
 - Easy Read version
 - A proxy version
 - Mixed-methods ASCOT for home-based care
 - Use of qualitative evidence with ASCOT

Applications of ASCOT (1)

Improving practice

- Funded by NIHR School for Social Care Research
- ASCOT Feedback Intervention Study (AFIS)
 - Evaluating impact of feedback to staff on outcomes for care home residents
- Developing a 'care home level' approach
 - Potential for quality assurance and monitoring
 - Presentation of results for use by users and carers

Applications of ASCOT (2)

Performance improvement activity

- Identifying the Impact of Adult Social Care (IIASC)
 - Identifying and exploring impact of current provision on service users and carers
 - Develop measures of impact for the Adult Social Care Outcomes Framework
- Maximising the Value of Survey Data in Adult Social Care (MAX) project
 - Understanding challenges faced by councils in using survey data
 - Supporting councils to make more use of data for local improvement activities

Application of ASCOT (3)

Assessment and Review

- SCEiP mini-project – Cumbria CC with some input from ASCOT team
- Using ASCOT in the Assessment and Review Process in Cumbria
 - Make assessment and review more outcome-focused
 - Developed tools to support the use of ASCOT within assessment and review process
 - Evaluated usefulness of ASCOT within the process

Applications of ASCOT (4)

Use in research and evaluation

- Personal health budgets evaluation (PHBE)
- Adult Social Care Environments and Settings (ASSET)
- Shared Lives for older people
- Birmingham study of outcomes from different provider types
- Exploring cost-effectiveness of home care
- Explore factors influencing quality of life of older people, people with LD
- Studies in Denmark, Italy, Finland
- Discussions with NICE
