- **Evaluation of the design of extra care housing**

Judy Torrington – University of Sheffield

*Evolve* is a building evaluation tool currently being developed by The University of Sheffield and PSSRU as part of project funded by Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council looking at the design of extra care housing and its impact on the quality of life of its inhabitants. The tool aims to capture best practice in design, and is intended for use by designers, housing professionals, commissioners, providers and older people in evaluating extra care schemes. This workshop will introduce the pilot version of the tool, and explore how it can be developed to best meet the needs of its users.

- **Putting personalisation into practice: the potential implications of personal budgets for extra care**

This workshop will draw on work on personalisation conducted in rural areas and for Housing 21. It will focus on micro and macro issues arising from the roll out of personal budgets, commenting on workforce, risk and market features applicable to extra care providers, tenants, staff and local communities.
