This is the latest updated volume in a well-established series bringing together information from a variety of sources to estimate national unit costs for a wide range of health and social care services. This report consists of tables for more than 130 types of service which as well as providing the most detailed and comprehensive information possible, also quotes sources and assumptions so users can adapt the information for their own purposes.

New in this edition

This year the Unit Costs report starts with a preface which discusses new developments and introduces a guest editorial and three brief articles. The guest editorial discusses how systematic reviews and economic evaluations of interventions inform health and social care policy and practice. The first article presents the costs of support organisations for people with direct payments and personal budgets. The second article describes the Social Care Institute for Excellence's work on economics and the importance of valuing unpaid care, and the third article describes the National Dementia Strategy published in 2009 which aims to ensure significant improvements are made to dementia services.
