Q1 Information about the survey

The data collected in the survey will be anonymous and we will use statistical methods to analyse and report it (for example "80% of respondents agreed that..."). We will share the anonymous data file with the Health Foundation, the funder of this research. The Health Foundation might use the anonymous data file for further analysis.

Once you have completed the survey, you will be invited to provide your name and contact details to enter the prize draw. This information will be stored separately from the survey data and will not be matched to your answers. We will only use this information to enter you into the draw. Five winners will be randomly picked from all entrants two weeks after the survey closes. We will delete names and contact details after the winners have been contacted. Participation in the prize draw is voluntary.
